## **FREE DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME SOLARIS™ SOLUTION FROM TERiX CONTINUES**

**Sunnyvale, CA—September 28, 2007—** TERiX continues to offer on its website a “free-of-charge” Day Light Saving Time (DST) public domain solution to the SUN Microsystems™ (SUNW-NASDAQ) Solaris™ user community running versions 2.5.1, 2.6 and 2.7 legacy operating systems.

With the advent of 2007 DST dates beginning March 11, and ending this upcoming November 4, many Solaris™ users require a software patch in order for the operating system to correctly calculate the time change. While Sun™ provides a public patch for Solaris 8, 9 and 10, no free public patch was made available for legacy versions of Solaris™ other than the solution offered by TERiX. TERiX created the DST patch for its clients running versions of Solaris™ no longer supported by the manufacturer, then decided to release the free patch into public domain as a service to the Solaris™ user community. The patch continues to be a popular download from TERiX website, even after the initial March 11 DST date.

“The entire Solaris™ community deserves a free DST patch and TERiX is delighted to provide it. TERiX has been in support of open systems and open source initiatives in the UNIX community for a decade and this offer is just another example of our commitment in support of the greater Sun™ user community,” stated Bernd Appleby, Chief Executive Officer at TERiX when the free patch was initially offered. “Our actions clearly support our Better Service--Better Value commitment to our customers and the industry,” Appleby added. IT Director Ian Waters states, “The TERiX DST patch was created using the same public domain resources and methodologies used by the manufacturer to write the DST patches for Solaris™ 8, 9 and 10. We were happy to assist the Solaris™ user community by packaging the publicly available time zone data and software as well as the necessary information to implement it”. Larry Quinn, Director of Sales commented further, “Now that we approach November 4, there are potentially users who will need to reset their systems of the over 10,000 server systems that have downloaded the TERiX solution and they should feel comfortable in knowing that TERiX DST solution is still available at no charge on our website.”
